# 115TH CONGRESS ACCOMPLISHMENTS



**4** ACEP-developed bills signed into law



**30** congressional letters of support or comment submitted



**555** legislative visits conducted by ACEP members and staff



**4,000+** members in the ACEP 911 Legislative Grassroots Network



**5,514** donors supported NEMPAC, the fourth largest physician specialty PAC



**\$2.2M** contributed by NEMPAC to **200 House** and **27 Senate** candidates during the 2018 elections.

## ACEP successfully secured passage of four ACEP-developed bills that were signed into law:

The **Protecting Patient Access to Emergency Medications Act** to provide needed clarity on EMS “standing orders” of key medications in the field, like opioids.

The **Sharing Health Information to Ensure Lifesaving Drug Safety (SHIELDS) Act**, included in the 2019 National Defense Authorization Act, to facilitate sharing of prescribing information for active-duty military members and their families between the Department of Defense and state prescription drug monitoring programs.

The **Alternatives to Opioids (ALTO) in the Emergency Department Act** to expand access to alternative pain management treatments in the emergency department.

The **Preventing Overdoses While in Emergency Rooms (POWER) Act** to help expand medication-assisted treatment programs for treating patients with substance use disorders (SUDs) in the emergency department and providing a “warm hand-off” to longer term SUD treatment programs.

Will Rogers once said, “Even if you are on the right track, you will get run over if you just sit there.” By participating in NEMPAC, you join thousands of your colleagues in promoting the shared interests of emergency medicine. If you don’t participate, you allow others to determine the future direction of our specialty. ***That’s a risk we can’t afford to take.***



# 2019 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICINE AND PATIENTS

- + Protect patients from surprise gaps in insurance coverage for emergency medical care;
- + Ensure patients are protected from insurer practices that discourage safe and necessary use of the emergency department;
- + Increase access to mental health resources for patients in need of psychiatric care and prevent “boarding” or holding patients in the emergency department until their inpatient beds are available;
- + Expand prevention and treatment options in the emergency department for patients with substance use disorders;
- + Promote research in emergency medicine and foster injury prevention activities; and
- + Improve safety measures to protect emergency physicians and staff from violence experienced in the emergency department.





## 2018 FEDERAL EXPENDITURES BY PARTY



### Total expenditures by chamber and party





### Total expenditures by committee type and party

# GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATE SUPPORT FROM NEMPAC

-  Co-sponsorship of ACEP-supported bills such as EMTALA liability relief and solutions in the ED to combat opioid abuse, drug shortages and access for emergency patients to mental health care;
-  Support of ACEP's efforts to protect the Prudent Layperson Standard and fight for fair access to and reimbursement for emergency care;
-  Support of funding for firearm injury research, graduate medical education, disaster preparedness, poison control centers, trauma centers and EMSC;
-  Relationships with emergency physicians back home and ACEP state chapters;
-  Leadership positions and health care committee assignments; and
-  **Willingness to work in a bipartisan manner for access to emergency care for all patients.** The NEMPAC Board of Trustees, comprised of ACEP members, approves a candidate budget for each election cycle. We rely on the input of ACEP state chapter leadership, individual 911 Network members and NEMPAC supporters when evaluating open seat and challenger races. We also ask non-incumbent candidates to complete a NEMPAC candidate questionnaire.



All non-personal contributions to NEMPAC will be used to defray costs of educational programs for NEMPAC and other activities permissible under federal law.*
