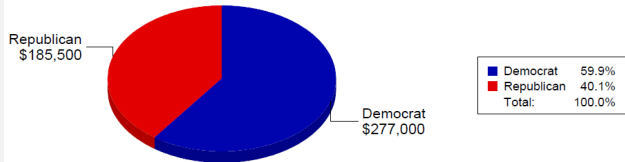

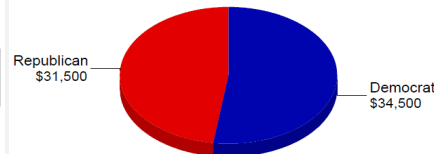


**Total Expenditures by Party**

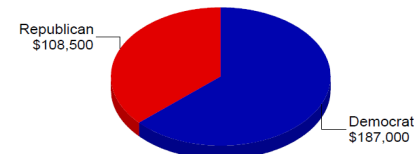


**Expenditures by Chamber and Party**

**Federal Senate**

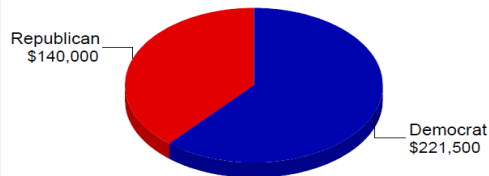


**Federal House**



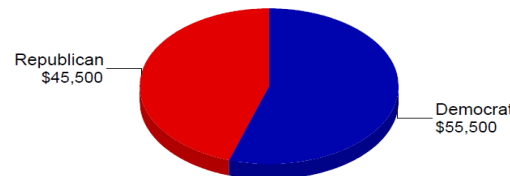
**Expenditures by Committee Type and Party**
