- What has ACEP been up to: started with council, resolutions that are taken to state houses and DC
- ACEP is a large machine. Board has been here for 7 days. Welcome to join board meetings. Kicked off week with 60+ resolutions. Varying topics: gun violence, pregnancy, mentoring research networks, workforce, healthy workforce, the match—analyzing early ERAS data—number of applicants is high and no attrition yet. Had elections: three new board members. New vice speaker. New president-elect.

- Conference this year with 8000+ attendees. Family oriented conference: childcare—trying to make this doable.
- Issue focus: boarding a public health crisis. Everyone experiencing this.
 Existential threat to our ability to care. Associated with burn out. Collected 140+ stories about boarding and poor outcomes and disseminated this to the White House—got a meeting with the White House—asking for help. Symptom of a systems problem.
- Boarding Summit 3 weeks ago in DC. Had diverse groups at the table (not just EM physicians). Trying to partner/collaborate regarding solutions.
- Launched ACEP open book. Online search tool for career moves. Online tool regarding employers, structure, models. ACEP Open Book. About transparency.
- Pipeline and Leadership: invest in our future now. Spearheading partnership with EMRA—select medical students/residents to have state advocacy
- Meeting yesterday with ABEM: one initiative—Leon Haley—launching and academy program. Bring in medical students to prepare them to be EM physicians.
- Emphasize need for us to show up. DIHE section, diversity section did not exist 4
 years ago. Change happens and is real. We all need to be engaged and get
 involved.
- Dr. Aisha Terry takes questions:

 - Started with EMRA. Get involved through the chapters (state level)—that is often where the pipeline begins. Begins with committee involvement. Get on these national committees. Honing your community around something you are interested in.
