









Georgia's needs growing much faster than provider supply

CCM MDs needed /100,000 population:











Physician Gap


Emory eICU patients were compared to those in nine hospitals in our region

An episode of care = hospitalization plus 60 days post discharge

Health Care Innovation Awards	 1 Billion Dollars 3000 Applications Only 1 first-round award in Georgia to the Emory program
Better Health	 Reduction of Mortality More patients sent home, not chronic care Reduction of 60 day readmission rates
Better Experience of Care	 Reduction of LOS and Higher Patient/Family Satisfaction
Lower Costs	 \$1486/patient episode (federal beneficiary) x 24,000 patients Estimate \$33.6 million saved while caring for Georgia's sickest patients

Challenge	Opportunities
Numbers: Too few experts for Georgia's growing population	 Use of on-site APPs Remotely supervised by Georgia-licensed experts As a destination state for aging, meets ↑demand for immediate access to providers and services
Time: Hard to staff unsocial hours	 Emory is the global leader "turning night into day" Attracting professionals to Georgia Rotating those Georgia professionals overseas
Distance: Rapid access to the best healthcare while remaining close to home	Telehealth industry built on making distance irrelevant: bring the expertise directly to the bedside
